A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR THE REVITALIZATION EFFORTS OF THE _____ (ORGANIZATION NAME) _____ TO DEVELOP DOWNTOWN MANTUA, AND PLEDGING FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO CONTRIBUTE ONE-THIRD (1/3rd) OF THE COSTS NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) OVER TWO YEARS

WHEREAS, various individuals and entities, including Village Council representatives, have participated in an ongoing discussion concerning identifying methods of further revitalizing and developing downtown Mantua; and

WHEREAS, these discussions are heading toward the formation of a nonprofit organization which will lead the downtown revitalization efforts, in part, by acquiring the services of a consultant who will outline a plan of recommendations; and

WHEREAS, Village Council desires to express its support for these efforts by enacting this Resolution, and pledging its support, by committing financial assistance not to exceed one-third (1/3rd) of the costs charged by the consultant, up to a maximum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) over a two year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Village of Mantua, County of Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Village Council hereby expresses its support for the committee and non-profit organization to be formed, which will focus their efforts on revitalizing downtown Mantua.

SECTION 2. Village Council further expresses its financial support for these efforts by pledging financial assistance in an amount not to exceed one-third (1/3rd) of the costs charged by the consultant, up to a maximum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) over a two year period.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


