



# “Art on the Hill 2012” GENERAL INFORMATION & ARTISAN APPLICATION



**EVENT DESCRIPTION:** “Art on the Hill 2012”, sponsored by the Downtown Mantua Revitalization Corporation (DMRC) will transform downtown Mantua into an entertainment arena with high-quality artists and craftsmen, local food vendors, demonstrations, children’s activities and musical entertainment. DMRC is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization whose mission is to develop and implement a consensus-based plan to enhance the appearance of downtown Mantua.

**LOCATION:** Prospect Street in the village of Mantua. Mantua is located 4 miles south of the intersection of state routes 422 & 44 and 4 miles north of Ohio Turnpike exit 193.

**DATE & TIMES:** Saturday, July 14, 2012- Event begins at 10 am & closes at 5 pm. Set up 7-9:15 am. Set up times will be assigned by booth number. Please arrive promptly at your designated time. When unloading your vehicle, pull up far enough to allow others to pass. Quickly unload and move your vehicle to a parking area. **DO NOT SET UP YOUR BOOTH UNTIL VEHICLE IS MOVED.** All vehicles must be out of the event area by 9:15 am. No tear downs permitted before 5 pm. All tents, equipment, etc. must be out & the area cleaned up by 8 pm.

**BOOTH INFORMATION:** “Art on the Hill 2012” is an outdoor venue. There are 90+ 10’ x 10’ booth spaces which will be assigned on a first come first served basis unless a specific request is made. Organizers will do their best to honor such requests. Artists/food vendors may supply their own canopy, display equipment, tables, chairs, etc. For safety, artists need to bring appropriate weights to secure their booths. Spikes and staking are not allowed, nor is tying off to any street fixture, permanent or temporary.

**BOOTH FEE:** \$45.00 and is due with this application. Sorry, we cannot refund booth fees for any reason. The deadline for booths requiring electric is June 20, 2012.

**ELECTRIC HOOKUP:** If electric is required, an additional fee of \$25 will be due with this application so the appropriate number/size of rental generators can be arranged. Vendors must supply their own heavy duty outdoor 12 gauge extension cord.

**ELIGIBILITY:** “Art on the Hill 2012” is open to all artists within the accepted medium categories.

- No work from commercial molds, kits, or manufactured work is accepted.
- Ceramic works must be hand made by the Artist.
- Photographs: prints must have been processed by the artist or under the Artist’s direct supervision.
- Exhibitors are prohibited from selling non-original promotional items (posters, t-shirts, calendars, etc).

**ART DONATION:** Since “Art on the Hill 2012” is a fundraiser, each artist is asked to donate an item to the Chinese Auction held on the day of the event. Artists may place business cards near their donation for additional advertising of their wares.
